Ethanol is a renewable, sustainable fuel. Today, the majority of gasoline pumped in America contains E10 - a blend of 10 percent ethanol and 90 percent gasoline.

Ethanol has slashed greenhouse gas emissions from vehicles. In 2016, **ethanol reduced greenhouse gas emissions by 43.5 million metric tons** - that's like removing 9.3 million cars from the road. Ethanol also replaces toxic gasoline additives linked to cancer and smog. Plus, **ethanol production requires less water than gasoline production by a three to one margin.**

Using higher blends of ethanol in gas will reduce harmful pollution even more. **E15 is EPA approved for all vehicles 2001 and newer including SUVs and light duty trucks.** It is the most widely tested fuel on the market.

And, these higher ethanol blends save you money at the pump and help engine performance.
